LOCKOUT – “SECURE THE PERIMETER”

STUDENTS remember to:

- ✓ Return inside of building
- ✓ Do business as usual

TEACHER remember to:

- ✓ Recover students and staff from outside building
- ✓ Increased situational awareness
- ✓ Take roll, account for all people in classroom
- ✓ Do business as usual



LOCKDOWN – “LOCKS, LIGHTS, OUT OF SIGHT”

STUDENTS remember to:

- ✓ Move away from sight
- ✓ Maintain silence
- ✓ Turn off cell phone

TEACHER remember to:

- ✓ Lock classroom door
- ✓ Lights out
- ✓ Cover windows
- ✓ Barricade doors & windows if necessary
- ✓ Move away from sight
- ✓ Do NOT open door
- ✓ Take roll, account for all people in classroom



EVACUATE – “TO A LOCATION”

STUDENTS remember to:

- ✓ Leave stuff behind
- ✓ Bring their phone
- ✓ Form a single line

TEACHER remember to:

- ✓ Grab roll sheet & red backpack if possible
- ✓ Lead students to evacuation location
- ✓ Take roll, account for all people with you



SHELTER – “FOR HAZARD USING SAFETY STRATEGY”

STUDENTS remember to:

- ✓ Practice appropriate
Hazards & Safety Strategies

TEACHER remember to:

- ✓ Lead appropriate Hazard & Safety Strategies
- ✓ Take roll, account for all people with you
- ✓ Report injuries or problems, at the evacuation assembly, using the Red/Green card system

SAFETY STRATEGY

Evacuate to shelter area
Seal the room
Drop, cover, & hold
Get to high ground
