

What to do if you have a received a Positive BinaxNOW™ result

Today, during required COVID-19 testing, you received a positive test result on the BinaxNOW™ COVID-19 Antigen Self-Test. Due to this, you will need to isolate.

You have choices on how to proceed:

1. Have this test result confirmed with a PCR test.
 - a. You can get tested at any community based COVID-19 testing center of your choice. You will need to be tested within 48 hours of the positive Binax result. You will need to notify the school of results as soon as possible. The Lakewood School District will not be responsible for any charges incurred for this test or subsequent care.
 - b. You can have a Curative test performed at Lakewood School District. These tests can be performed at any school site during normal school hours. These tests are provided to our staff free of charge. Results will be available in 48-96 hours. A registration link for this test can be found on the District Website at <https://wa50000091.schoolwires.net/Page/1475>.
2. Isolate for 10 days. They will not be able to participate in school or any school related activities during this 10-day period.

You will be contacted in the next 24 hours by an employee of the Lakewood School District to further discuss these options and confirm when you may return to work. If you choose to a PCR test as follow up, you will need to isolate at home until test results are received. You must speak to either the District Nurse or the Director of Human Resources prior to returning to work.
